- Tribe received \$600,000.00 grant for work at the intersection of Suquamish Way and Division which includes a traffic light, buried high voltage lines, and turn pockets.
- Shell station and mini mart moves across the street into expanded quarters larger than the Masi shop. If yet to be drawn up plans are approved by the Tribal Council, work could start in 2011.
- Michael Felts returns as Suquamish Foundation leader.
- Bookmobile a possibility for Suquamish.
- Tribal student library at the Tribal Center on Sandy Hook joins with the North Kitsap School library system.
- Neighbors along South Angeline are interested in developing the Hemphill road end as a picnic area and beach access.
