

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Kitsap County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing on **December 11, 2006** at the hour of **10:00 a.m.**, in its Chambers, County Administration Building, 619 Division Street, Port Orchard, Washington, to consider enacting an **Ordinance** posting 25 mph speed limit on local access roads in all Commissioner Districts and further described as follows:

WHEREAS, RCW 46.61.415 provides that the Local Legislative Authority may determine and declare reasonable and safe maximum speeds, and

WHEREAS, RCW 46.90, known as the Washington Model Traffic Ordinance, was adopted by the Local Authority in Ordinance No. 68-1976, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 68-1976 Section 3, provides for a speed limit of 25 mph on any county road not otherwise posted,

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners to amend Ordinance No. 68-1976 to clarify its application,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Kitsap County Board of County Commissioners:

Section 1. Amendment. Kitsap County Code Section 46.02.030, adopted by Ordinance No. 68-1976, is hereby amended as follows:

46.02.03 Speed limits on un-posted roads

It is unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to operate such vehicle in excess of twenty-five miles per hour on any county road which is not otherwise posted. The Public Works Department shall have the authority to post or not post Local Access roads as appropriate with speed limit signs for 25 mph.

ALL THOSE INTERESTED are welcome to attend the hearing. **(Please note that hearing start times are estimates and may be impacted by the amount of public input).**
