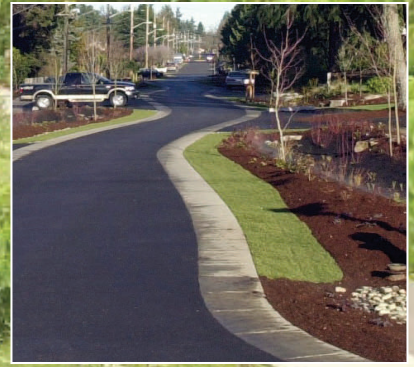


Low Impact Development Informational Workshop



Current trends suggest that low impact development (LID) is an important tool to manage stormwater and protect our receiving waters. In response to this growing awareness, the Puget Sound Action Agenda and new regulatory requirements, local jurisdictions are increasingly applying LID in the Puget Sound region.

To assist Kitsap County in reviewing appropriate stormwater standards for all scales of development, Curtis Hinman will provide an overview of design guidelines, science, construction details, and practical experience necessary to properly design, build and maintain LID practices. Mr. Hinman is the WSU Extension LID Specialist and lead author of “Low Impact Development Technical Guidance Manual for Puget Sound.”
