

**Surface and Stormwater Management Program
Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes
July 7, 2011**

1. Introductions were made
2. Meeting Minutes of April 28, 2011 were approved with change to meeting date.
3. A revised version of the Water Policy Implementation Plan will be sent to the Committee
4. Citizen Members: The committee is one representative each from Central Kitsap and South Kitsap. Some term limits are also coming up. For those who may know an interested party from CK or SK, or those having terms coming to an end and would like to stay on the committee, please contact Rebecca Pritle.
5. Lou gave a brief description of the book "The Ripple Effect" and recommended it highly to the group.
6. Mindy Fohn gave a briefing on the SSWM Outreach & Education program and what they have accomplished with regard to the NPDES permitting process. Areas discussed included NPDES Permit, E&O strategies, Evaluation and SSWM Partner Coordination.
7. Eva Crim gave an update on the Pollution Identification and Correction (PIC) Program. Discussion included field methods, prioritization of PIC areas, shellfish harvesting area monitoring, WQ results over the past several years, and plans for the future.
8. A short discussion of water re-use and reclaimed water issues followed.
9. Kathlene Barnhardt briefed the group on the status of the Kitsap Shoreline Master Program (SMP). State adoption is projected for Fall 2012.
10. Partner status reports included: KCD; a discussion of the Fairgrounds LID Grant, stream restoration projects, the rain garden program and agricultural assistance program. WSU; a discussion regarding stream stewards; beach watcher program and shore standards; rain garden mentors; high school rain gardens (SeaGrant) and water courses.
