Advisory Group Purpose/Mission Statement

To provide the Board of Commissioners policy advice on the Surface and Stormwater Program commensurate with Resolution 109-2009 and the County's Stormwater Management Goals.

Accomplishments in 2010

1. Reviewed SSWM Partner Agency scopes of work for 2010 and helped develop improved scopes of work for 2011. Assisted SSWM Partner Agencies in the development of appropriate Performance Measures for 2011.
2. Strongly endorsed Kitsap County low impact development (LID) stormwater management standard for new development and promote the use of LID as a first choice for redevelopment and retrofit of existing development.
3. Reviewed and strongly supported the implementation of the *Water as a Resource* Policy of the BoCC (Resolution 109-2009) and provided further feedback to the BoCC on the policy.

Proposed Goals/Objectives or Plans for 2011

1. Continue to support the SSWM programs to develop a consistent and simplified framework for better articulating their goals, objectives, and performance measures.
2. Recommend meaningful ways to significantly implement components of Resolution 109-2009 "Water as a Resource" Policy.
3. Consider surface and stormwater impacts and goals as they relate to the regional initiatives outlined in the Puget Sound Partnership (PSP) Action Agenda. Make recommendations for incorporation of regional goals into the Kitsap SSWM program.
4. Provide review and recommendations for funding approval to Kitsap Conservation District for Backyard Stream Restoration Grant project proposals.
5. Become more involved with county land-use planning decisions from the perspective of stormwater management and reducing the impacts of development on aquatic resources.
